

Things to know...

- Tuition credits will not be given due to absences, holidays, early release, or bad weather days
- Parkhills Preschool will start the first Tuesday after Labor Day weekend
- Parkhills Preschool closely follows the NEISD calendar for holidays, early release, and bad weather days
- Absences, holidays, early release, and bad weather days will not be made up
- Children will not be accepted before 9:00am
- Pick up time is 2:00pm. A late fee of \$2 for every 5 minutes after 2:00pm will be assessed
- Children will not be released to unauthorized adults
- All children must bring a lunch
- Label all items brought to school
- Children must bring a blanket or mat for rest time
- Dress appropriately for school play
- Inform director of any allergies or special needs at the time of registration
- Any child who has had fever, diarrhea, or a contagious illness or disease within 24 hours of a school day, may not be left at our program
- If your child becomes ill during the day, you will be notified immediately
- Medication will not be administered to any child during our program

▶ Parkhills Preschool is a Parkhills Baptist Church weekday ministry for children age 6 months (as of Sept 1st) through pre-kindergarten. Classes meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the months of September through May. We provide a program that allows children to grow and develop as Jesus did — “in wisdom and stature” and “in favor with God and man” Luke 2:52. Our school provides opportunities for children to learn about God’s world and how to live in it.

At Parkhills Preschool, our focus is to instill a love of Jesus and a love of learning. We are a school that seeks to foster and nourish each child as they grow physically, emotionally, mentally, and spiritually.

PARKHILLS PRESCHOOL GUIDELINES

- 6 months by Sept 1st
- Pre-Kinder students — 4 years old by September 1st

Registration & Supply fees are non-refundable and are due at registration.

TUITION

- \$225 per month / 2 day
- \$125 per month / 1 day
- Families with multiple children enrolled at Parkhills Preschool will receive a \$25 discount off monthly tuition for each subsequent child
- A late fee of \$25 will be assessed to outstanding accounts after the 10th of the month
- A 4% discount will be given when the 17-18 tuition payment is paid in full by September 10, 2017
- A 4% convenience fee will be assessed on Parkhills Preschool 17-18 online payments

▶ Individual, small group, and large group activities are planned to meet the specific needs and interest of each age group.

Every child, from our youngest baby to our oldest Pre-Kindergarten student, is learning throughout their day. Whether they are learning how to crawl or walk in line, or whether they are learning shapes, numbers, letters, and how to write, they are acquiring knowledge and skills that will advance them to the next level in the learning process.

Every age group enjoys Music class each day. Children ages 2 and up will also attend Big Church and Spanish class.

Our 3 year old and Pre-Kindergarten classes incorporate the Get Set for School program which is an introduction to the Learning Without Tears curriculum. This curriculum includes materials for handwriting, pre-reading skills, and math concepts, and is a Kindergarten ready program. This curriculum is used in conjunction with units of study such as Community Helpers, weather and seasons, space, math, science, reading, social studies, and much more.
