

ON-CAMPUS WORSHIP GUIDELINES & INFO

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Worship Center has been open since May 3, 2020 for live worship and will continue for the foreseeable future. In compliance with the order from Bexar County Judge, Nelson Wolff, everyone attending worship must wear a mask.

We were planning to reopen Connection Groups in July, but due to the increase in COVID-19 virus cases, we are going to postpone the reopening for now.

SOCIAL DISTANCING & SAFETY MEASURES:

- Those who are sick or showing any symptoms of illness should stay home and worship via our Livestream.
- Those who are at a high risk of complications from illness should consider staying home.
- Those who choose to join us on-campus – A FACE MASK MUST be worn at all times while you are in the building.
- Enter through the front doors. All other doors will be locked. THE DOORS WILL OPEN AT 10:30 AM.
- Use only the pews that are designated seating.
- To efficiently utilize seating in the worship center, families are asked to sit together.
- Extended session/childcare of any kind remains suspended until further notice.
- We ask that you refrain from hugging and shaking hands. We know that comes naturally in this building and it will feel unusual, but please help us keep social distances.
